# Facilitators- Helping Migrant Workers Fighting Against Coronavirus



## Needs Assessment:

From the perspective of child caring, we found out that in the pandemic period

1. The migrant workers and their children only get the fragmented and uncompleted information about epidemic prevention. It is difficult for them to distinguish the authenticity of the information , which will affect the epidemic prevention and their confidence for the future life;
2. Because of the pandemic, migrant children and their parents lived a dull and monotonous lives which cause tensions or even conflicts;
3. Limited by their parents' educational level and learning resources, the migrant children can not get access to the learning guidance so their studies and psychological development will be affected.
4. Under the epidemic situation, not only the migrant workers' families have less access and interaction to the outside world, but also lack platforms to participate and express. The weak social supports resources play an even weaker role, leading to more lack of social supports.

# Facilitators- Helping Migrant Workers Fighting Against Coronavirus

**Goals:** children-oriented services

1. Assisting the migrant children and their family to cope with the difficulties in their studies and helping them to foster the habit of studying from home;
2. Enriching their extracurriculum activities and expanding their knowledge to the outside world;
3. Facilitating the quality time between the migrant children and their parents;
4. Aiming to help the migrant children and their parents to participate in social affairs by improving their awareness and prevent against the new epidemics.

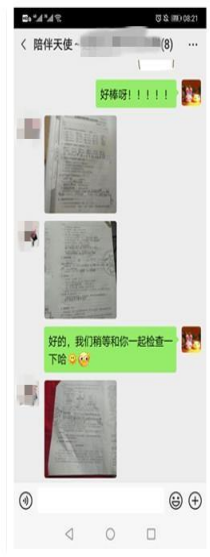
- **Community-focused:** online construction for self-support and mutual help

# Facilitators on Helping Migrant Workers Fighting Against Coronavirus



- **Conclusions**

- From the perspective of system theory and based on children, a child-family-community-society four-dimensional services model for migrant children is formed.
- From January 22 to March 31, the team of facilitators carried out 154 online services on 9 topics for migrant children and their parents during the pandemic period, serving a total of 176 migrant worker families, benefiting 1,604 people directly; issued 93,669 yuan as livelihood relief and living allowances for 88 poverty-stricken migrant families; provided protective materials for 622 needy families (1090 adults and 686 children), including 10233 masks, 249 Lego piles, and 438 cans of Nestle infants milk powder, 634 brochures; published 94 special articles with a total of 42581 reads; released 495 short messages with a total of 283,000 reads and 59 media reports.
