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01 The COVID-19 response activity of One Foundation

This activity started on 22nd Jan. There are over 798 organizations together with 157,72 people cooperated with One Foundation aiming to help the distribution of the supplies and implementation of the pandemic prevention activities in the more than 2 months.

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02 The intervention for mothers in late pregnancy




1、The newborn babies in Wuhan are around 120,000 to 130,000 which means there are at least 10,000 pregnant women in Wuhan for the past month.

2、After the outbreak of the coronavirus, many local hospitals have shifted into the medicare designated hospitals for treating the pneumonia and stop offering pregnancy check-ups. There are also many restrictions for the Wuhan residents in their communities or traffic, which made the local citizens find it difficult to go out.

3、At the beginning of February, the public payed more attention to the coronavirus instead of the pregnant women.


Pregnant women are the most susceptible groups in the society, we offer the online doctor consultation



Frequent outgoing in the pandemic period will increases the risks for the pregnant women and their babies and also added more pressure to the mothers.

The COVID-19 response activity of One Foundation-Responses

- 1.Special needs—priority to elderly/ patient in critical situation/ Front-line personnel/ people are quarantined mandatorily
- 2.Recruiting Wuhan—Hubei province
- 3.Recruiting—shortened mothers pregnancy 34 weeks to 32 weeks, the service will continue to the delivery of the baby
- 4.Logistics—passed by local volunteer (Hubei Xiaogan coalition, Yunbao rescue team)

03 The intervention for the people with intellectual disability



- The people with intellectual disability need to participate in behavioral intervention training on a daily basis. Any interruption may lead to degradation.
 After the outbreak of COVID-19, residents were restricted from entering and exiting the community and had traffic restrictions. They didn't understand why they couldn't go out, so they were prone to emotional and behavioral problems.
- 3、Behavioral degradation and travel restrictions led to greater parental stress and more obvious emotional problems.



- 1、Behavioral intervention courses and professional training.
- 2、Individuals and families need professional psychological counseling.
- 3、Family care issues for parents in isolation, and lack of supplies in remote isolation areas.

The intervention for the people with intellectual disability-Action



Establish an **emergency assistance network** for the "special need families" in the outbreak(most members are local parent organizations).

Local grid responds to the emergency assistance network for 10 areas affected most by the epidemic, including:

Online Course Development

Behavioral intervention training and emotional counseling of the people with intellectual disability, develop courses and conduct online teaching by special education institutions, behavioural training at home and psychological counseling online.

psychological Support

For stressed parents: Open hotline and WeChat channel to provide psychological support.

Resource Mobilization

Home care and material needs: Discover needs, and contact local communities, streets, and disabled people's federations to obtain care and material support. Assisting families with

intellectual disability to be tested and referred.

The intervention for the people with intellectual disability-Effects



- 1、Online courses: Xiaomeng Class, Autonomous Life
- 2、Draft action guide for emergency network member units
- 3、Aid information collection form

4、Network construction: As of March 4, it covers 29 provinces / autonomous regions / directly-controlled municipalities in the country, with a total of 131 cities and counties. Through screening, 286 organizations have been confirmed to provide necessary support for families with emergency needs, and for the safety and basic living security of the people with intellectual disability.

04 Caring activities for the children of the medical personnel



Launched by Yongzhen




