At the time of the interview, (4/4/20) India had few cases.

The Government decreed the quarantine and curfew.

The economic situation of the city and the country was already being affected.





 There was a very complicated situation for 39 mexicans stranded in different regions of the country.

 In the second contact (16/4/2020) the Mexican embassy succeeded to repatriate safely all the citizens to Mexico.





Interviewing Pedro Neto, a Brazilian Economics student



- At the time of the interview (2/4/20) The first cases arrived to Sao Paulo from international travelers.
- The federal government has not taken the proper measures recommended by WHO.
 - The national economy is predicted to drop at the beginning of the second semester of the year.





At the second contact at 20/4/20 the situation is getting worse since the population is not respecting the quarantine.


The country is facing a strong Political crisis due to Covid 19.
