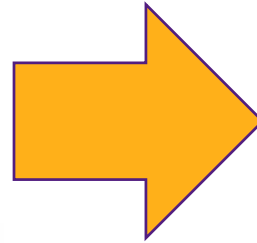

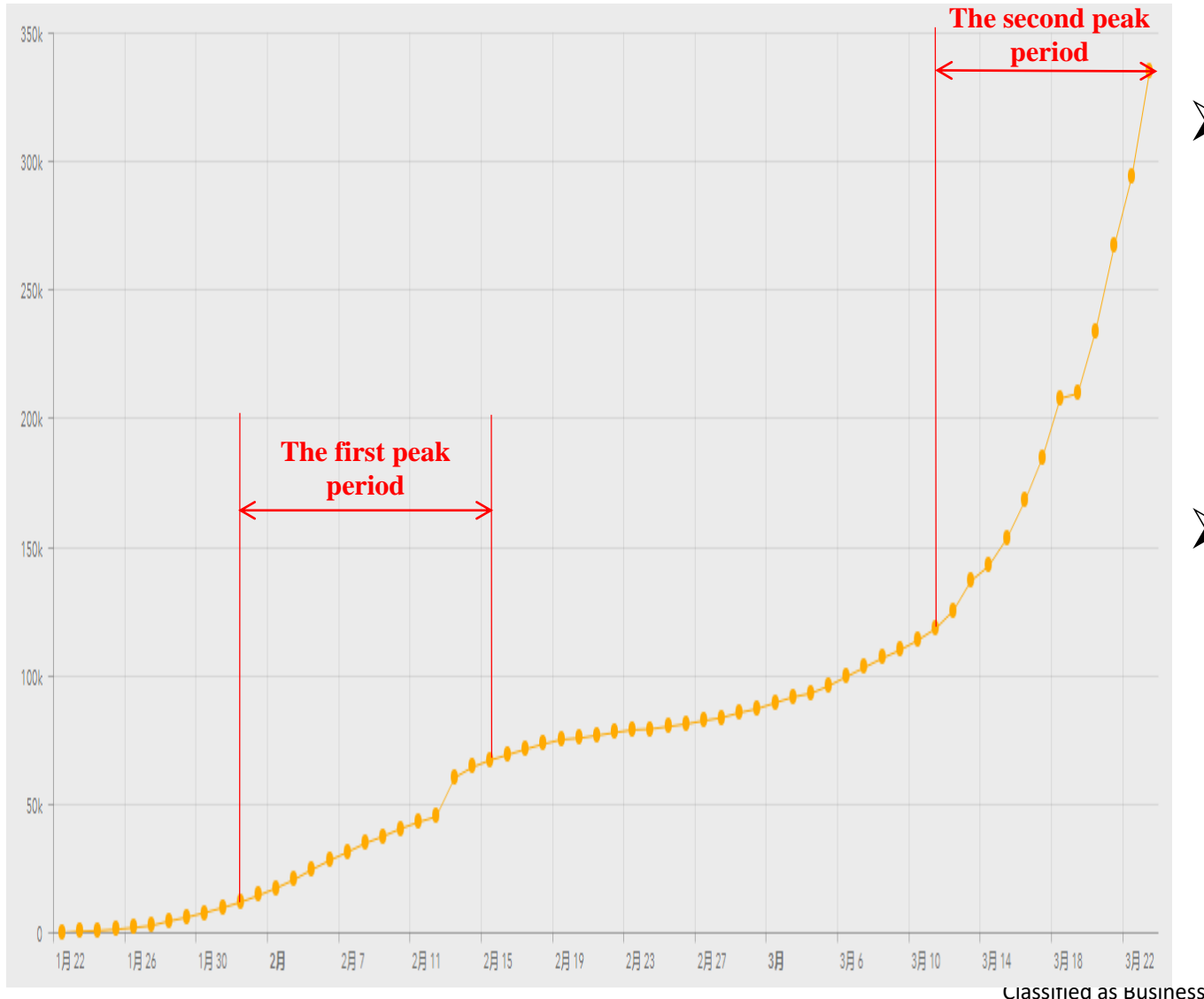

- **The second peak period:** March 11th to the present, there are a large number of confirmed diagnoses in many countries around the world, and the upward trend is very obvious.

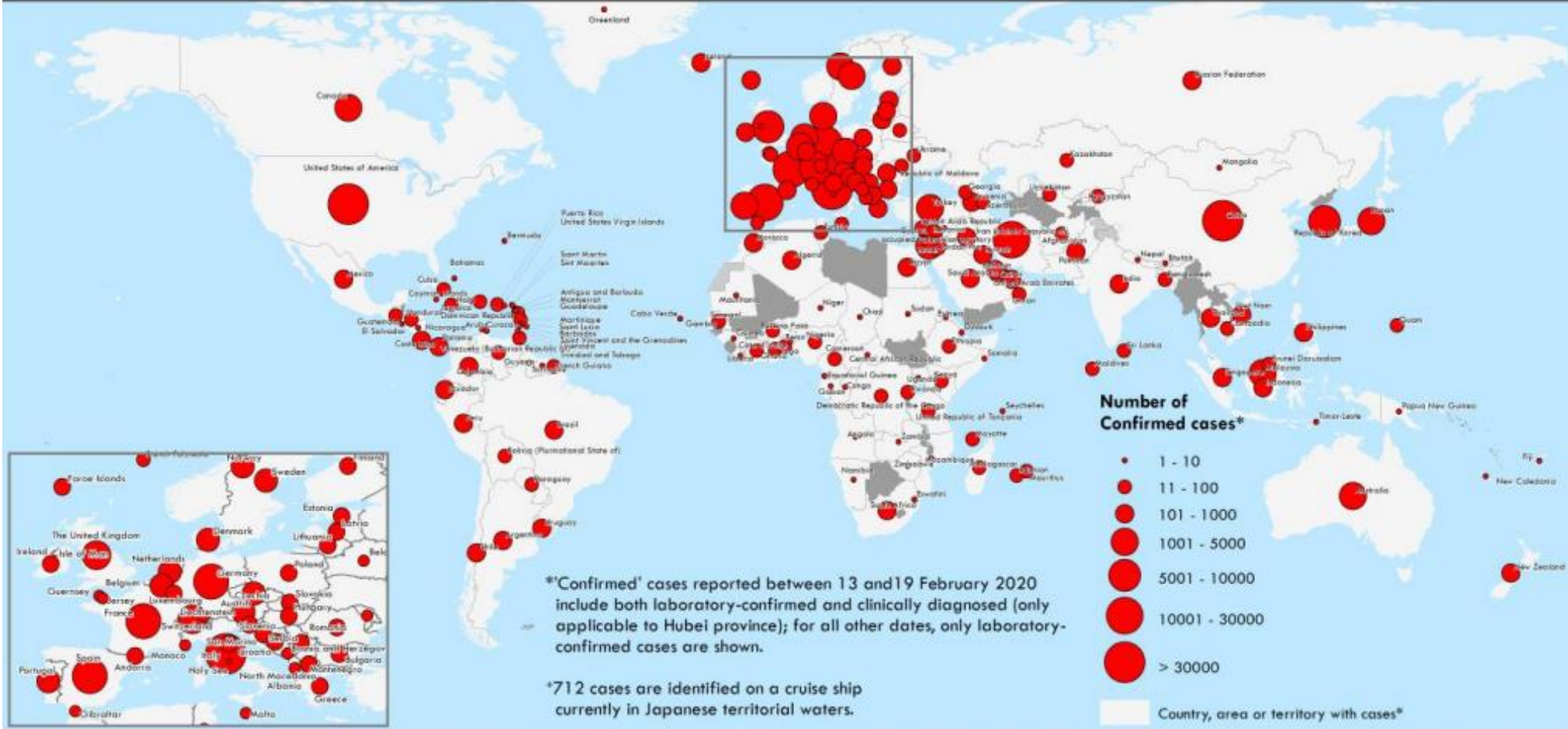


# c) Europe becomes epicenter of the pandemic

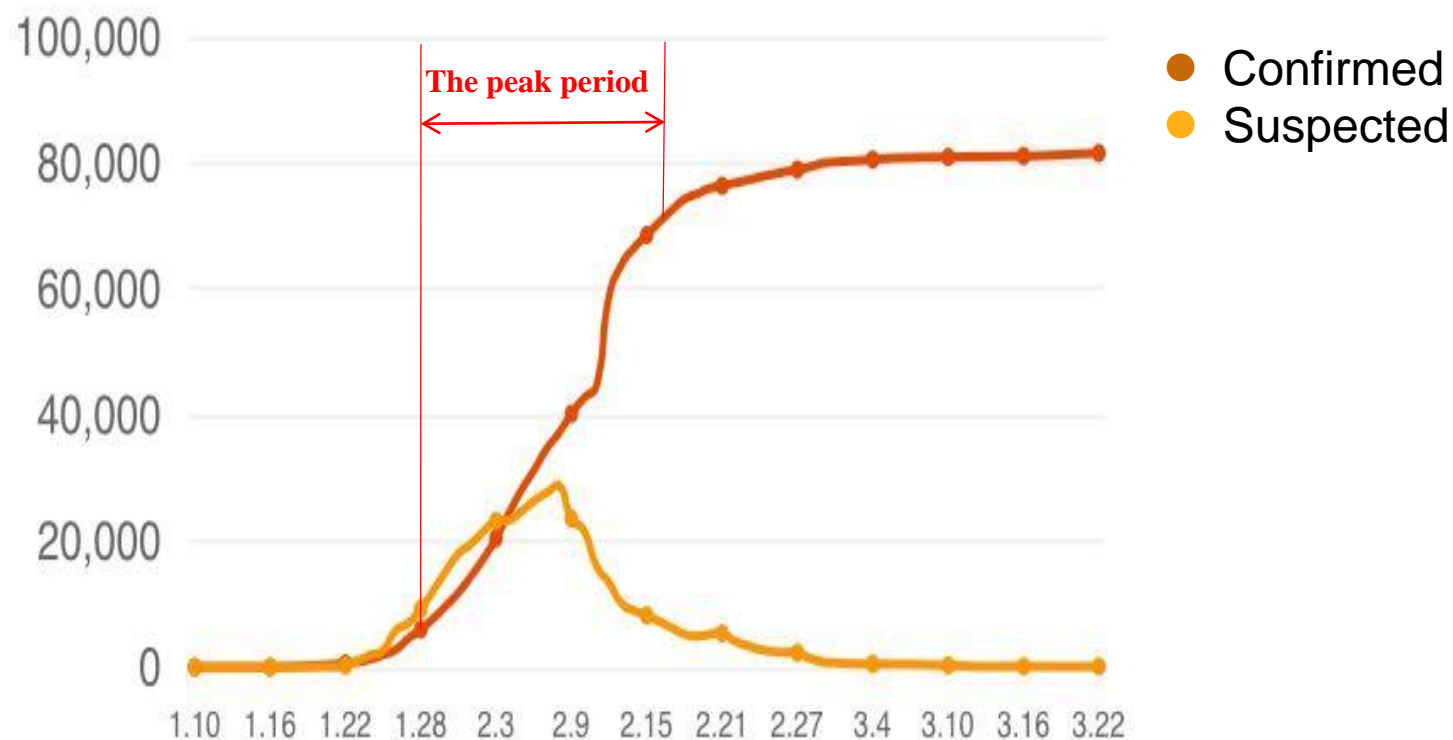

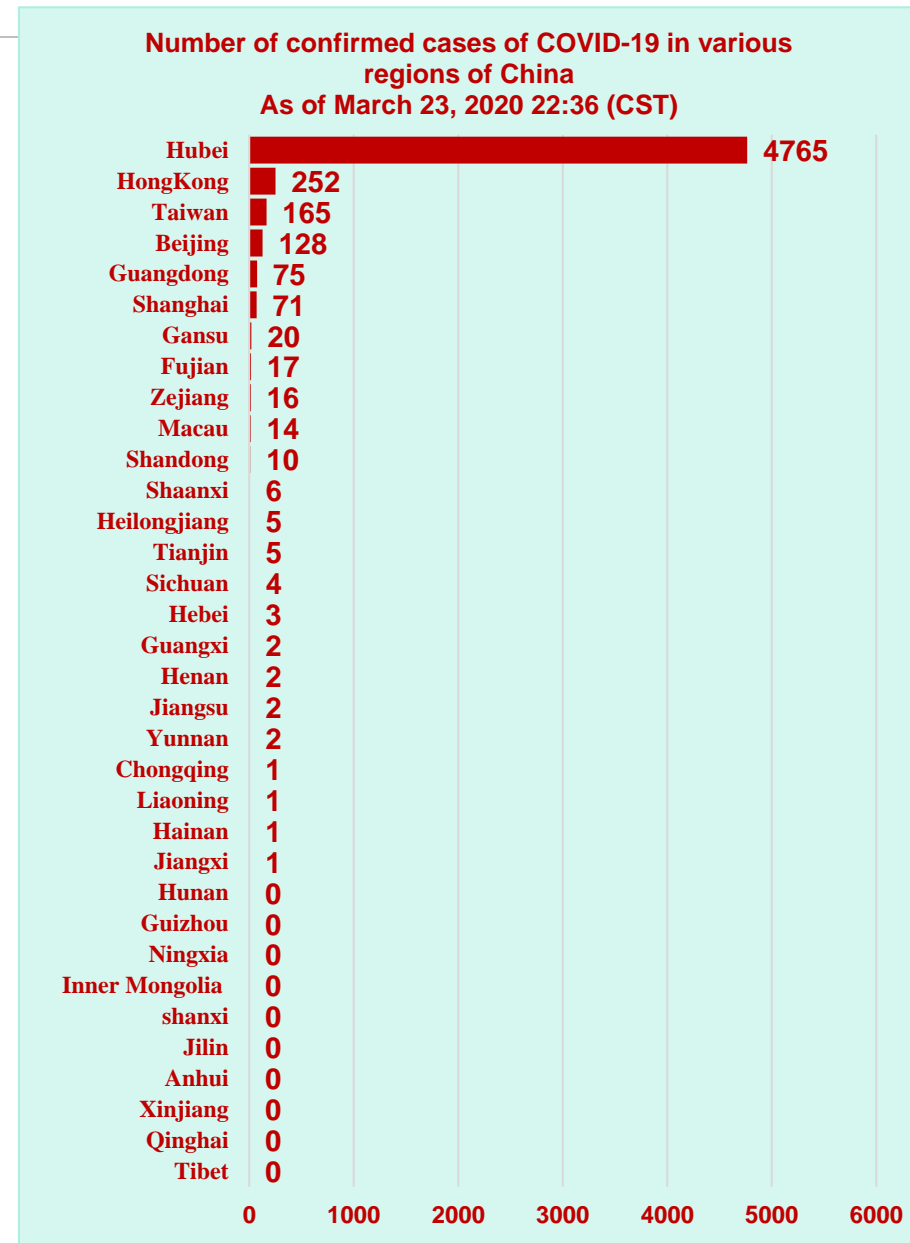

## b) Chinese Prevention and Treatment Experience

---

### ➤ Prevention

- Stop production
- Publicity and education
- Scientific protection
- Active participation of social forces

### ➤ Treatment

- Identify the source of infection
- Effectively isolate the source of infection
- Controlling the total number of people infected
- Strictly control severe runs

## c) China's response

---

- The outbreak is basically under control
- The emergency response has been downgraded
- Many cases were cleared
- The medical team was evacuated in an orderly manner
- Gradually resume production
- Carry out international assistance operations



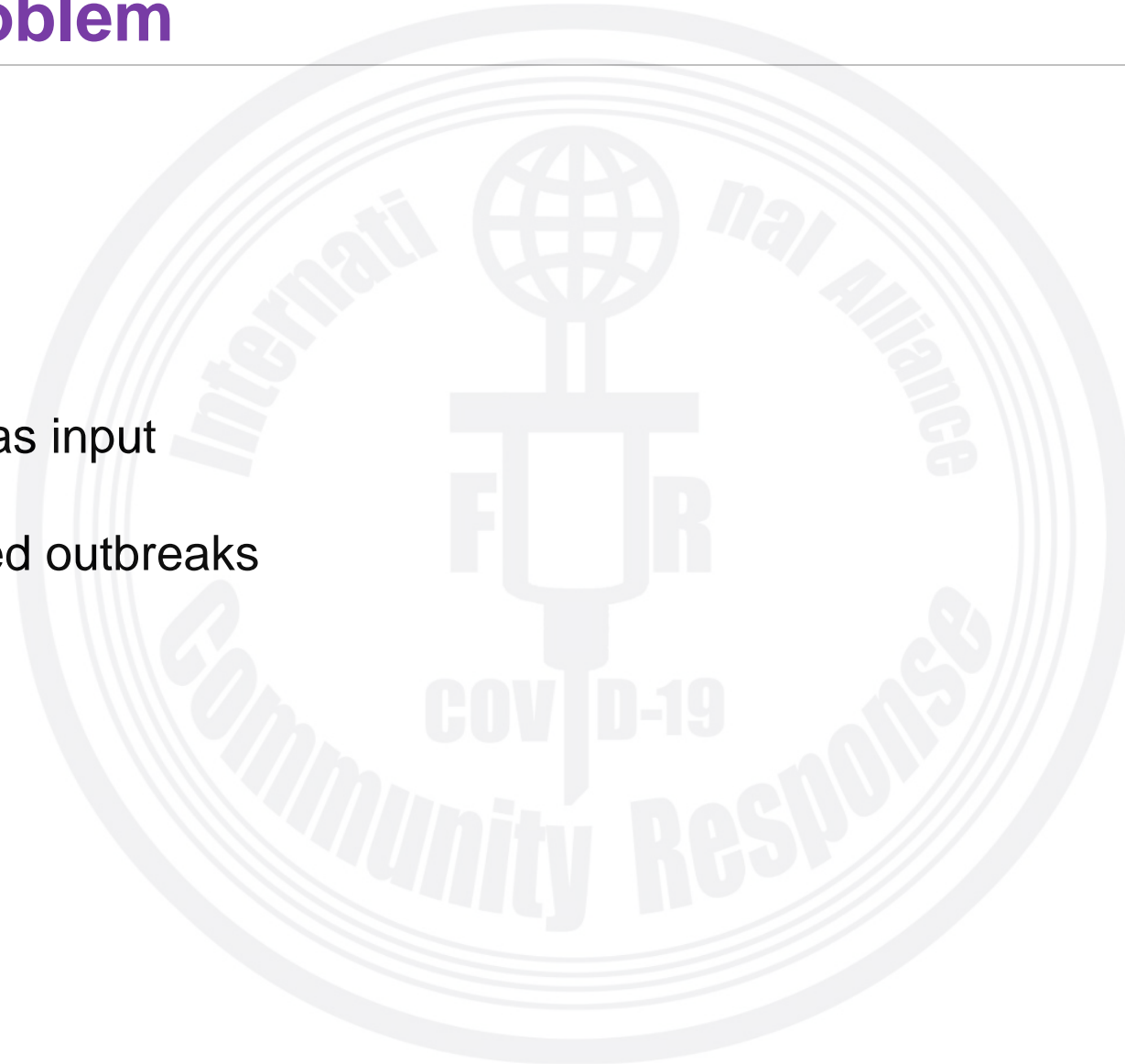
