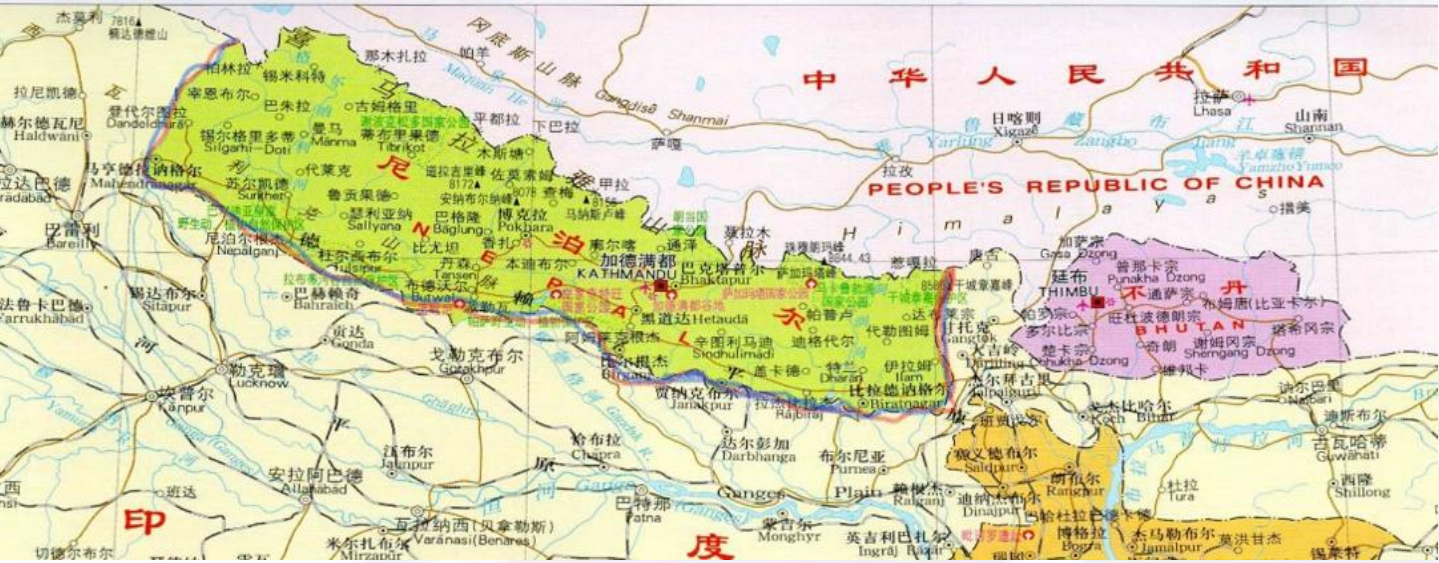

Project Background

Nepal Epidemic Situation

- The pandemic caused by the novel corona virus has threatened the entire human race and all the countries are concerned about the safety of its population.
- Currently, more than 3 millions infections in the world
- Nepal is more vulnerable due to open border with India and the rapid rise in the number of cases in India
- A nationwide lockdown imposed in the country to curb the outbreak



Why more emphasis on washing hands ?

- Through “Washing Hands” sounds cliché, it is extremely important, especially in fighting Corona Virus
- As per the latest data, only 3 out of 5 people Worldwide have basic hand washing facilities
- Hand washing one of the cheapest yet most effective way to combat COVID – 19
- Even those who wash hands do not know the proper way and are negligent
- In developing countries, large number of people dwell in rural areas where washing hands is not common
- Washing hands prevents not only COVID – 19 but a multitude of other diseases as well

People's anti-epidemic capacity in the project implementation area

- Sudden announcement of the lockdown by the government
- No time for preparation and workers stranded in their workplace with minimum resources
- Social distancing a privilege for the rich only
- Not enough information to the people of rural areas regarding epidemic, and its prevention
- A large number of people face problems of food supply due to poor economic condition

Long – Term Benefits !

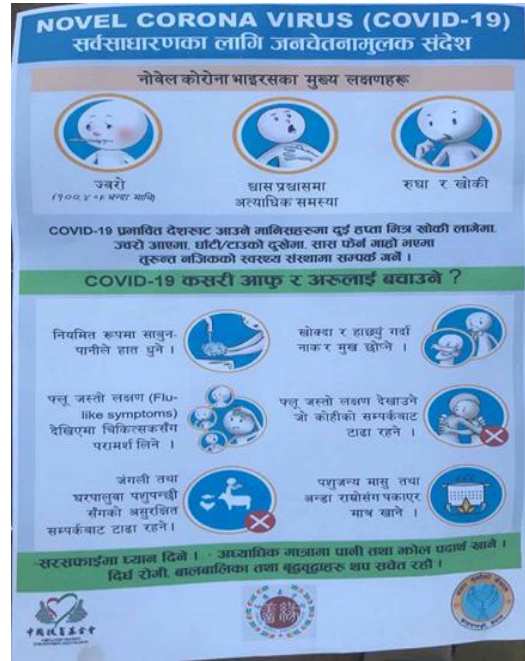
- The programs will habituate a large number of people to wash hands regularly

KATHMANDU, April 5 (Xinhua) -- China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation (CFPA), a Chinese non-governmental organization (NGO), has handed over materials needed for hand wash stations to Nepal's Mithila Bihari municipality.

The materials, including buckets and sanitizer, were handed over recently to the municipality located 9 km away from the province's popular city Jankapur.

The COVID-19 pandemic is spreading. On March 27 the China Foundation for Poverty Alleviation (CFPA) launched the "We are together" program, whose aim is to join with the international community and help developing countries fight against COVID-19, end the epidemic, and return to normal as soon as possible.

On March 28, with a donation from the Tibet Good Will Foundation, CFPA and Safa Sanaulo Nepal jointly launched the Nepal community COVID-19 project, the first initiative in the "We are together" program in Nepal's second largest province Janakpur. The deputy mayor of Mithila Bihari, Anita Kumari Sah, and representatives of local community attended the launch ceremony. They expressed their gratitude to China. The mayor said at the ceremony, "It is critical for Nepal to prevent COVID-19. Thank you to China for establishing such an important and urgent project here."

This project will donate sanitation buckets and disinfectants to poor and vulnerable communities, establish checkpoints and clinics in some districts in Janakpur province, Pharping province and Kathmandu, and set up 180 hand washing stands. The aims of the project are to raise people's awareness and correct misconceptions in the regions regarding transmission of COVID-19 and recovery from the virus. Timely and efficient communication, and identification of urgent requirements, play a crucial role in epidemic prevention at an early stage, and the project enables CFPA and corresponding partners to protect the health and wellbeing of people in need.

To date Nepal has 5 confirmed cases of COVID-19. Given that Nepal has relatively poor health-care services and lacks medical infrastructure, staff and equipment, coronavirus prevention will be a huge challenge. The government decided to lock down the country until April 8.

项目产出

Our project:

- Distribution of sanitation materials to the people of underdeveloped region to help them fight the pandemic
- Help the frontline health workers, police personals and others at high risk of infection by providing them necessary materials
- Increase the level of public awareness in the community so that early actions are taken by the citizens to prevent infection
- To set a model on how to react to the pandemic so that other local and national bodies imitate it for the prevention damage caused by outbreak

Involvement of Local Bodies

- Many village committees and municipalities have emulated our programs for their villages and towns
- The local people, with raised awareness, have shown their ardent involvement in understanding public health issues
- The elderly people of rural areas have become more health conscious

Promising Changes

“What we do these days will shape the world for years to come. Lets come together and vanquish the common enemy”

- The setting up of hand wash station has raised awareness regarding the importance of a simple but a crucial habit. Consequently, the locals are getting habituated to washing hands.
- Once the wash liquid is exhausted, the locals buy soap or wash liquid on their own and put them at the wash station.
- The locals have become aware of the proper way to wash hands, and many individuals have corrected the way they used to wash hands.
- The establishment of wash stations has made the general people become aware regarding the gravity of the situation.

Followed by Local Community

- During this pandemic situation, people from different communities have stepped up to set up in different vulnerable place of their community to control the pandemic situation
- Local communities have initiated to work to maintain the hygiene among the people, among community so as to stay away from COVID -19 virus amidst ongoing global pandemic by setting up hand wash station



- The people of the community have put buckets not only in their community only but also in the community around them so that they can also prevent the spread of dreadful COVID -19 in their communities
- In a dense community, hand wash station was set up with small bucket considering the outbreak of global virus. Seeing such an initiative of local community, CFPA Nepal Office later kept big buckets each to help them in hand wash comfortably



Consequential Changes

- the communities now have hand wash station including small buckets and soap., CFPA Nepal Office, later, has placed huge buckets in communities which have largely contributed in controlling pandemic COVID -19 (small to big-----short time to long term)
- Less people have the habit to wash hands ,after the hand wash station set up (with big bucket) by CFPA Nepal Office, number of people washing hands through hand wash station has exceptionally
- CFPA Nepal Office initiation of setting hand wash station including big bucket and liquid hand wash has apparently helped in maintaining hygiene among community people in comparison to earlier days

Mrs. Shanti is in her early seventies; she is more health-conscious compared to other elderly people of her area. Because of her healthy lifestyle she has become an epitome of hale individual among all the elderly people of the village. When the radio and TV stations started broadcasting news and other awareness-raising programs regarding the outbreak caused by the novel corona virus, she became curious and went to meet the nurse of the local hospital. The nurse, who lived in her community, taught her all the preventive measures. Mrs. Shanti now washes her hands more often than before to keep herself healthy; she advises others in her village to do the same.

The sanitation center established by CFPA has made it easier for the villagers to wash their hands. When the hand wash liquid provided by CFPA was exhausted, she provided her own soap at the wash station so that others do not have to face any difficulty. She keeps on encouraging others to adopt healthy behaviors to fight the pandemic.
