


Yicang


China is a state of ceremonies, providing mutual support is a convention in Chinese culture.

In ancient China, the government set granaries called Yicang to store cereals for disasters since Sui Dynasty, more than one thousand years ago. Yicang reached the peak in Qing Dynasty. There were Yicang granaries all over the country, and some of them were set by civilian institutions. In bumper harvest year, people stored cereals in Yicang, and opened the granary to help victims.

In addition to relief, ancient Yicang also provided social security, education, financial cooperation and other services, like modern foundations do.


度 有成 Nowadays, Yicang is an action and cultural system, which is composed of love warehouse, bazaar, advocacy activities, capacity building and a series of volunteering activities. It breaks traditional "give-receive" mode and provides a friendly and warm environment that people can participate equally and easily.

Some people donate one kilo noodle per month. Some kids donate a small bag of salt per month with their pocket money. Even, some residents are willing to spend one hour to chat with the seniors who live alone in the same community. Each family, including the poor, positively donate their necessities to Yicang according to their actual income and preference. The vulnerable can get warm and respect from Yicang.

After a long time, volunteers will manage Yicang in their own communities and this mutual assistance system will be a part of the local people's life. The interpersonal trust will be rebuilt in communities and neighborhood-help culture will be formed gradually.









Advocacy Activity

A Spoon of Rice & Porridge from Hundreds of Families



Appeal people to knock at strange neighbors' doors and raise a spoon of rice from them. All the rice will be used to cook porridge and share with all neighbors for getting closer to the neighborhood. It's related to the Chinese traditional culture. In some places of China, there is a custom that porridge from hundreds of families can keep kids healthy and away from the evil things.

In this way, they can understand their community better and know more neighbors.







Bazaar-Yiji



Yiji is a platform for collecting community resource and promoting communication among neighbors in the same community, as well as a bazaar held regularly in public places, once a month.

In Yiji, local residents can sell secondhand things like books, clothes, and hand-made food like cookies, pickles. Some local companies also can sell discount goods in the same place. The poor can sell something to earn living costs. Each vendor is supposed to donate necessities to Yicang with money get from Yiji. What's more, folk artists can show their talent on the stage. You see, everyone living in the community can participate Yiji and help others in different ways.

Yiji is not only a place full of joy, love and care, but also be a part of the community life. This is important for people living in Chinese urban communities.


Advocacy Activity-National Yicang Festival Hi! Neighbor!







At present, Yicang development network has been set up.
